Introduction

The GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING (GNPHN) owns and runs the www.gnphn.com website. The GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING needs to collect and use certain information about you when you use any of the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING 's online services.

The GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING is committed to protecting your privacy and takes the security of your information very seriously.

The GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING aims to be clear and transparent about the information we collect about you and how we will use that information.

The Data Controller

The GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING is the Data Controller for all personal data which is collected and used by the website. A Data Controller is the legal entity which determines how and why personal data is collected and used.

The Data Protection Officer (DPO)

The GLOBAL NETOWRK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING has appointed a Data Protection Officer to oversee the GLOBAL NETOWRK OF PUBLIC HEALTH

What Personal Data we Collect

Personal data means any information relating to you which allows the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING to identify you, such as your name & address, contact phone numbers and email address.

Most areas of the gnphn.com website can be accessed by you without the need for you to provide any of your personal data. Some areas, though, require you to submit your name, email address, and other contact details, for example where you work

The GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING may collect and use the following personal data about you:

- Your name, address, contact telephone number, and email address,
- The communications you exchange with the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING as part of signing up for membership or attendance at an event

Site Tracking

The GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING uses tracking software to help use monitor users traffic patterns and site usage to help us develop the design and layout of our websites. The tracking software may collect the following technical information about your use of this website:

- IP address
- The data and time when you accessed the website
- The page you visited on the website
- Total time you spent on the website
- Geographic location (country only) of the computer device used by you to connect to the website.

What we use your Personal Data for

Any personal data we collect from you on this website will only be used by the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING for the following purposes:

- To register you as a member of GNPHN
- To register you to attend a conference/events run by GNPHN
- To provide you with a better customer experience by making services available online
- To process a complaint

- Analysis of visitor traffic to and usage of our website
- To distribute various GLOBAL NETOWRK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING newsletters and information notices regarding GLOBAL NETOWRK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING
- Campaigns and promotions which the GLOBAL NETOWRK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING feels may be of benefit to you.
- To gain your feedback on this website

The GLOBAL NETOWRK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING will not use the data we collect about you on the website for any other purposes without first contacting you and seeking your consent.

The GLOBAL NETOWRK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING may use anonymised data from this website for the purposes of analysing, planning and improving the service. This anonymised data will not include any of your personal data.

How long will we hold onto your Personal Data

The GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING will only retain your personal data for as long as it is necessary to fulfil the purpose it is being processed for. When the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING no longer needs your personal data, they securely delete or destroy your personal data.

Who will have access to your Personal Data

Only GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING staff, agents who are directly involved with the management of www.gnphn.com website shall have access to your personal data which is collected by this website.

All GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING staff, agents and suppliers which may have access to personal data shall be bound to the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING via confidentiality agreements and are obliged to keep your personal data secure, and to use it only for the purposes specified by the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING .

Will my personal data be transferred outside of the European Economic Area (EEA)

The GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING uses Google Analytics to collect information about your use of this website and part of this information includes your IP address which is considered personal data. However, the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING has anonymised IP addresses for this website which means that no individual can be identified by the IP address. As it is an international organisation, data may be shared outside the European Union but restricted for GNPHN administration purposes only.

What are your Rights

Under certain circumstances, by law you have the right to

- **Right of access** – you have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you.
- **Right of rectification** – you have a right to correct data that we hold about you that is inaccurate or incomplete.
- **Right to be forgotten** – in certain circumstances you can ask for the data we hold about you to be erased from our records.
- **Right to restriction of processing** – where certain conditions apply to have a right to restrict the processing.
- **Right of portability** – where certain conditions apply, you have the right to have the data we hold about you transferred to another organisation.
- **Right to object** – you have the right to object to certain types of processing such as direct marketing.
- **Right to object to automated processing, including profiling** – you also have the right to be subject to the legal effects of automated processing or profiling.
- **Right to review:** in the event that the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING 's refuses your request under rights of access, we will provide you with a reason as to why.
- **Withdraw your consent** – where you have consented to receiving emails or newsletters you may withdraw your consent at any time

When submitting a request, the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING may need information from you to confirm your identity.

Once your identity has been confirmed, the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING will supply you with your information free of charge, however, we may charge a reasonable fee if believe your request is clearly unfounded, excessive or repetitive.

Making a complaint

In the event that you wish to make a complaint about how your personal data is being processed by the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING , or how your complaint has been handled, you have the right to lodge a complaint directly with the Data Protection supervisory authority and the GLOBAL NETWORK OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING Data Protection Officer:
